Overview of the Role

GAN is looking for a someone to join the team to control code releases through development environments, create reports on sprint development, and schedule releases to GAN's production environments. You will report directly to the Infrastructure Director, learning the skills you need to manage releases while bringing to GAN strong reporting and organization skills.

You will join a tight-knit and growing devOps team, acting as the glue that keeps us coordinated, organized, and in sync. Each project manager tracks major projects – sites, games, apps, features, bugs and live issues with each project needing its own progress through our development environments, and scheduling to release to live environments, either as part of GAN's 6-week development sprints, within a scheduled midsprint release, or as an emergency release. You will be the gatekeeper on any release to any environment, preventing unauthorized changes from moving up, and collating multiple requests into combined releases.

Duties & key areas of responsibilities

We need someone with a keen mind to organize that development, commit the to defined processes, to sync GAN's many project teams' code into sensible chunks of changes through the environments, and then report on it.

- Organize and manage code releases
- Schedule Sprint, mid-sprint, and emergency releases
- Control the change process
- Create Jira dashboards to show and report on the status of each project, and each environment
- Collate the status reports from each Project Manager
